Mandan Park District Board of Minutes June 2, 2014

The Board of Park Commissioners duly met in special session on Monday, June 2 at Mandan City Hall. Those present were President Arenz, Commissioners Keller and Knoll, Director Higlin, Phil Carlson and Stuart Krahn from Stantec.

President Arenz called the meeting to order at approximately 4:00pm, CDT. The purpose of the meeting was to get an update of the long range land use and transportation comprehensive plan.

Stuart Krahn presented the update on the Park District comprehensive plan. The peer cities for comparison were Williston, Dickinson, and Aberdeen SD. The Mandan Park District currently provides 20 acres per 1,000 people and 22 miles of trail per 1,000. In order to meet the population growth needs in 2020 of 25,858. The Park District will need to plan for acquiring 140 acres to keep the 20 acres per 1,000. The 140 acres would be comprised of eight 5 acres neighborhood parks and three 25 acre community/regional parks. The inventory for the future green space is still being collected.

To meet the demand of trails in 2020, the park district will have to plan for an additional 24 miles of trail to keep the 22 miles of trail per 1,000. The long range map demonstrated areas of green space and trail expansion.

A Motion to adjourn the meeting at approximately 4:55pm was made by Commissioner Keller and seconded by Commissioner Knoll.
