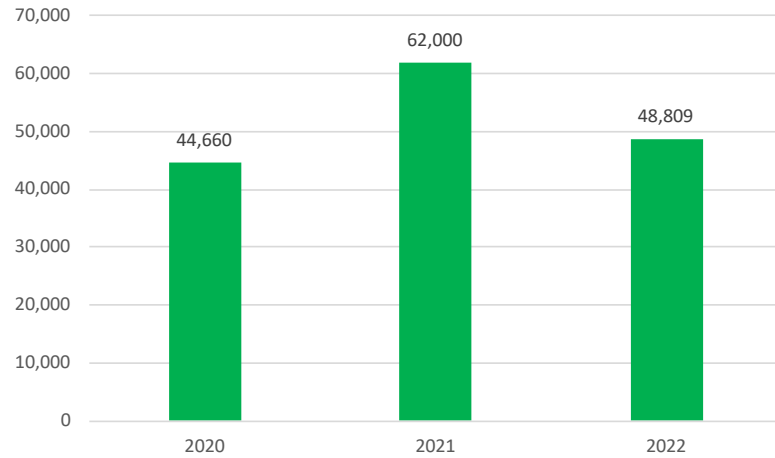

Rounds of Golf



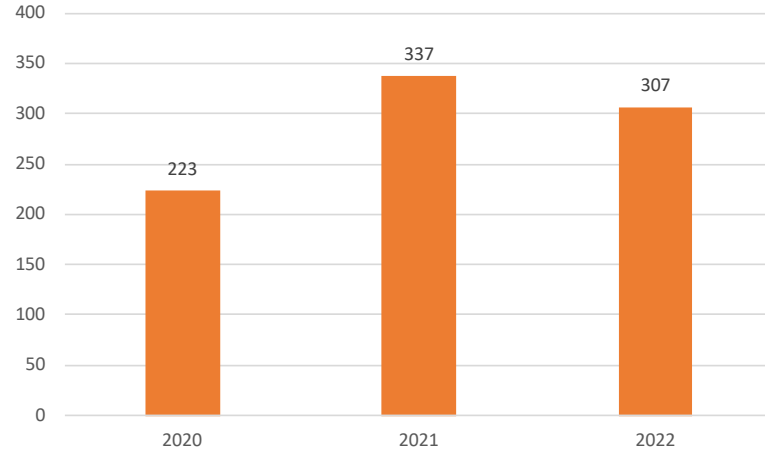
- 57 Golf Events

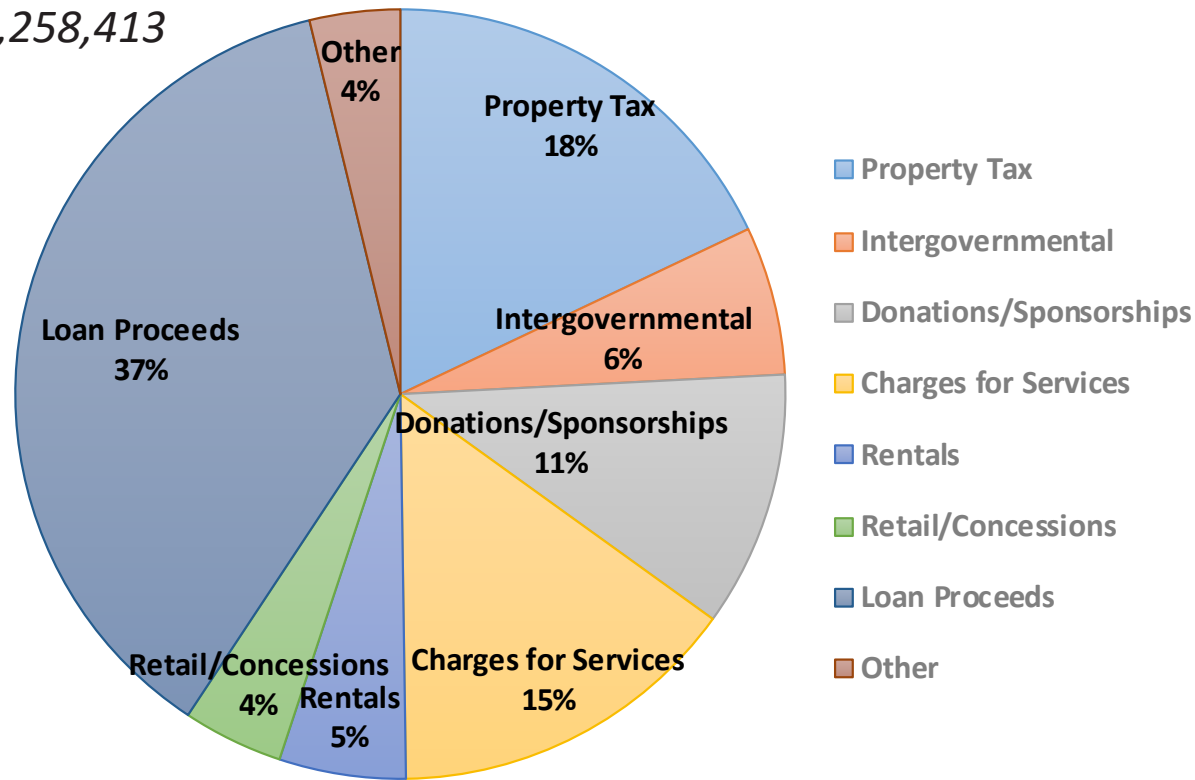

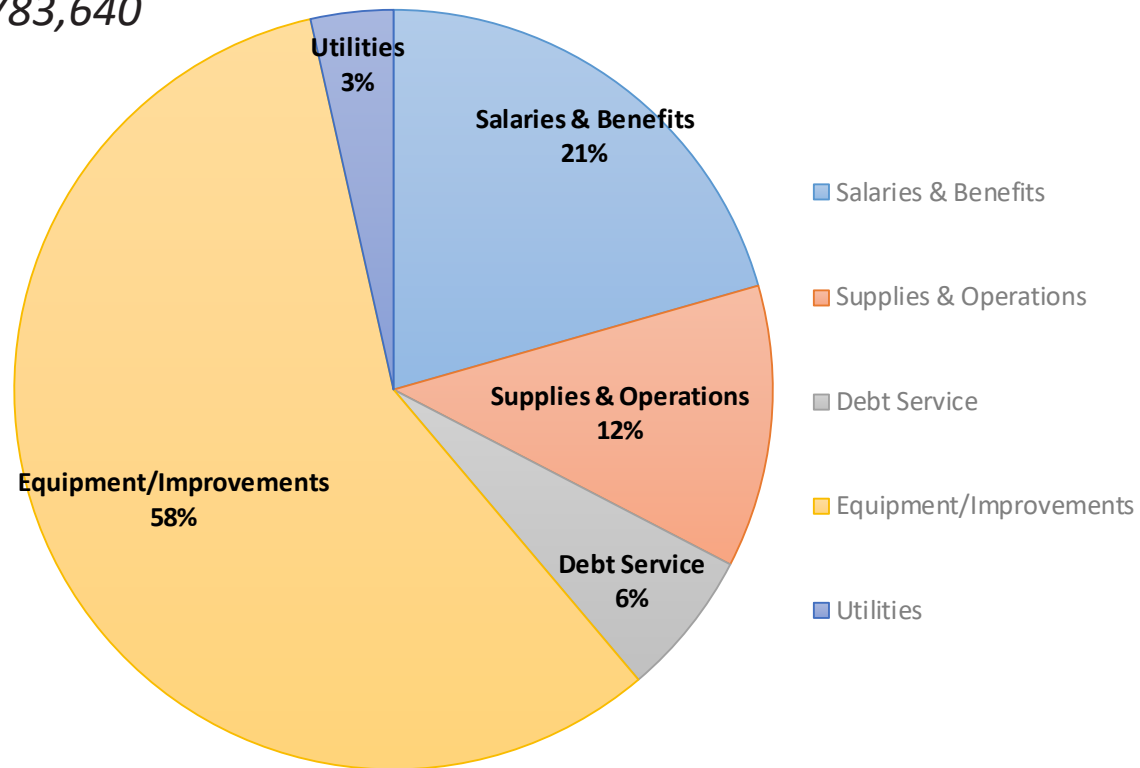


Mandan Park District

Expenses = \$14,783,640

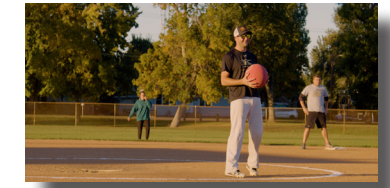


- Established a Foundation

- Began conversion to a more automated purchasing card system

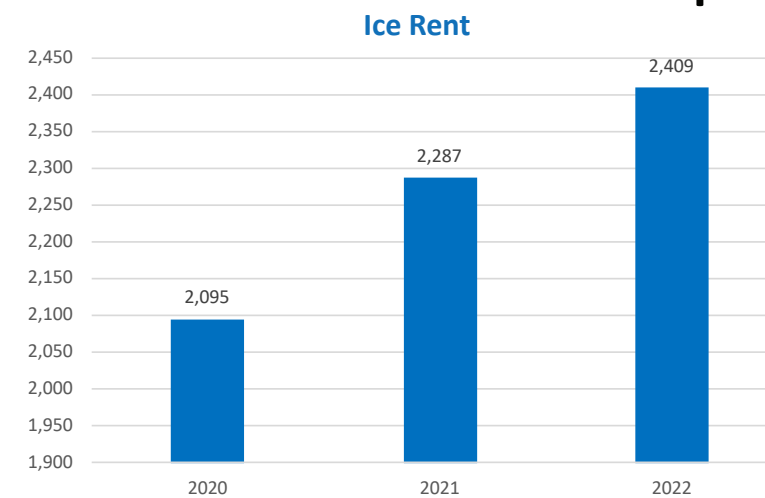

- Stanley Cup was featured at Starion Sports Complex

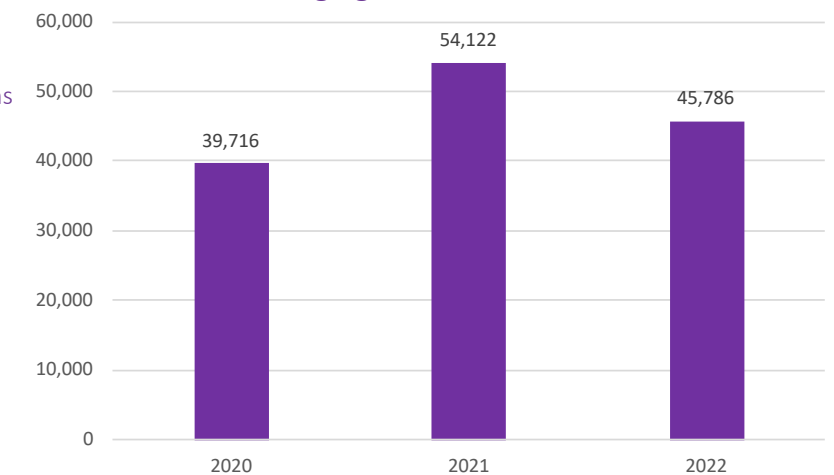


Raging Rivers Waterpark
