Mandan Park District Board Meeting Minutes August 10, 2020

The Board of Park Commissioners duly met in special session on Monday, August 10th, 2020 at City Hall, 205 2nd Ave NW in the Bosch Froelich room.

Attendees:

Park Commissioners: President Wade Meschke, Commissioners Jen Froehlich and Miles Mehlhoff. Park District Staff present: Teri Welch, Dustin Fleck, Garret Schultz, Brad Olson and Cole Higlin.

Legal Council: Arlen Ruff

Absent:

Vice President Jason Arenz and Commissioner Hatzenbuhler.

President Meschke called the meeting to order at approximately 5:30pm, CDT.

Public Communication: No one appeared.

<u>Minutes</u>: Motion by Commissioner Froehlich and seconded by Commissioner Mehlhoff to approve the July 13, 2020 regular meeting and July 20, 2020 special meeting. Motion passes 3-0.

Item #1: Director Higlin stated that land is potentially coming up for sale with the Mrnak Family who recently inherited the property adjacent to hole # 9 at Mandan Municipal GC. Staff feel that we can use this property for future storage or potentially expanding our parking lots. Director Higlin asked if we can proceed with discussions and bring back a proposal for the Park Commissioners to consider. President Meschke stated that there are no concerns among board members and keep us informed as negotiations continue.

Item #2: Director Higlin presented an engineering agreement with Burian & Associates for data collection for 6 wells for irrigation to analyze results and suggest mitigation strategies for improving our water quality. The current iron in our wells has wrecked havoc on our irrigation systems at baseball, softball, and soccer fields. The second phase would be a full study for a long term water solution for PWGC and determine if Missouri River, Heart River, and Wastewater Treatment recycled water could be an option. Park Superintendent Fleck demonstrated damage to his existing irrigation system and roughly spends around \$8,000 to \$10,000 annually repairing lines and sprinkler heads due to the iron content. Golf Superintendent Schultz echoed the same concerns and stated that we could possibly connect the irrigation system at PWGC and bore under the road to the youth soccer fields. Motion by Commissioner Mehlhoff and seconded by Commissioner Froehlich to approve Burian & Associates in the amount of \$8,900. Motion passes 3-0.

<u>Item # 3:</u> Director Higlin presented the engineering agreement with KLJ in the amount of \$49,000 for Old Red Trail multipurpose path reconstruction project that was approved last month. The Park District received \$168,237 in federal funding and is responsible for 20% plus engineering costs. Motion by Commissioner Froehlich and seconded by Commissioner Mehlhoff to approve KLJ for engineering services in the amount of \$49,000 for Old Red Trail multipurpose path. Motion passes 3-0.

<u>Item # 4:</u> Accounting Manager Welch presented the 2021 preliminary budget which was approved at our July 20, 2020 annual budget retreat.

Highlights of 2021 Budget:

- i. Budget is for 21 FT employees to receive a 2% raise (1% COLA and 1% merit) and Managers could qualify for an additional 3% for salary adjustments. We currently have two FT positions open that we are going to try and staff with seasonal employees for 2021. These positions are in Accounting and the shared maintenance position between SSC and the Park Shop. These areas will have increases to their part time salary line items.
- ii. Health insurance rates will increase by an estimate of 15% in July 2021. Total budget in 2021 will be \$390,800. Despite the rate increase, our budget is \$12,000 less in 2021 than 2020 due to having two unfilled FT positions.
- iii. No matching grant allocation and travel and training has been reduced.
- iv. Marketing budget was increased \$4,000 to celebrate our 100 year anniversary.
- v. We are levying property taxes based upon an estimated mill value of \$100,771 and no increase in the number of mills levied. Because of the increased value of the mill, however, this will result in approximately \$131,823 of additional property tax dollars levied in 2021.
- vi. The average increase in existing property values is 3.4%. An existing owner of a \$275,000 home with no valuation adjustment should not see an increase in property taxes. If their home increased in value by 3.4%, their property tax increase will be approximately \$12 for the year.

Capital Outlay

The beginning fund balance in 2020 was \$835,399. Currently we have \$125,000 restricted for a new ice resurfacer in 2022. For 2021 we have a total of \$426,150 in budget requests. These include:
