## Mandan Park District Board Meeting Minutes December 13, 2021

The Board of Park Commissioners duly met in special session on Monday, December 13 2021, at City Hall, 205 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave NW in the Bosch Froelich room.

Attendees:

Park Commissioners: President Wade Meschke, Commissioners Jason Arenz, Miles Mehlhoff, Chad Hatzenbuhler and Jen Froehlich.

Park District Staff present: Cole Higlin and Teri Welch Legal Council: Arlen Ruff

President Meschke called the meeting to order at approximately 5:30pm, CDT.

Public Communication: No one appeared.

<u>Minutes</u>: Motion by Commissioner Froehlich and seconded by Commissioner Hatzenbuhler to approve the November 8, 2021 regular meeting minutes. Motion passes 5-0.

**Item #1** Director Higlin introduced Brent Weber as the new Golf Professional for both golf courses. Mr. Weber will be replacing Brad Olson who is retiring Dec. 31,2021 after 21 years of service to the Park District. Director Higlin stated that Garrett Schultz will be the new Golf Operations Manager and Mr. Weber will report directly to him and Director Higlin will supervise Mr. Schultz starting Dec. 1, 2022.

Item #2: Director Higlin presented approval to bid the new rodeo arena. Keith Swenson from ICON Architecture Firm presented an overview of the design. Attorney Ruff developed an agreement between the Park District and the Mandan Rodeo Days Committee in case there is a shortfall of pledges and/or additional expenses relating to the construction of the rodeo arena. Mr. Swenson stated that the main lower-level grandstands at DCP currently sit on dirt and need piers and concrete underneath them to avoid the wave in the entire section. Currently we do not have enough aisle to meet code to allow patrons to enter/exit the rows properly. In addition, we do not have enough ADA spots and chain link needs to be 54' instead of 42' that currently encloses the bleachers. If steps are higher than 30" we need to enclose the steps for safety. In order to repair these items, concrete work under lower bleachers is \$51,403, retrofit existing bleachers for ADA/Code/Safety reason is \$160,000, plus \$25,368 for contingency and \$10,000 for design fees for a total cost of \$246,771. Director Higlin stated that \$250,000 from the \$1 million contribution from the Mandan Visitors Fund was dedicated for this renovation. Director Higlin stated that the lighting project is a direct expense to the BMSCA and they will determine what type of project will move forward pending costs. The cost estimates of the new arena are \$518,471 for site work, \$1,593,300 for the arena which includes electrical, aluminum bleachers for 4,000 seats, bleachers canopy, and crow's nest structure will be donated by Pahlke Steel. Project contingencies are \$253,413 and design fees are \$90,000. Total cost estimate is \$2,455,184. Director Higlin stated that the Mandan Rodeo Committee stated that they now have contractors who are willing to donate their time and materials to the project to assist with the funding shortfall. In order to give every contractor a fair opportunity to bid and donate portions of the costs back to the project, we have to bid the project assuming that we will won't get any donations to avoid any bid requirements from NDCC. The alternates are the following: alternate (1) is pavilion, ticket booth, and video screen totaling \$767,000 and alternate (2) is arena equipment, hospitality structure, and horse stall shelters totaling \$253,413. President Meschke stated his concerns on the overall construction costs vs funding in place. Mandan Rodeo Committee representative: Dan stated that we have secured donated labor and materials for this project once bids come out. It is difficult to determine the amount donations that I can give back to the project, its unknow until I see the bid package. We have electrical wholesale firms that will also donate materials once the plans are distributed. President Meschke has concerns with the \$1 million shortfall based on preliminary cost estimates. Motion by Commissioner Arenz and seconded by Commissioner Mehlhoff to approve advertising the Dale Pahlke Rodeo Arena at Dakota Community Bank & Trust Rodeo Grounds. Motion passes 5-0.

**Item #3:** Director Higlin presented approval to hire KLJ Engineering Firm for the design and construction of the Mandan Tennis Center. The subcontractor selected to assist in the design/construction is EAPC and Prairie Engineering who were involved in the renovation of the Fore Seasons Golf Dome in Bismarck. The difficult part is trying to coordinate sanitary sewer, water lines needed for the tennis center to coordinate with the contractor who is installing the 16<sup>th</sup> Street utilities. Director Higlin stated that the engineering contract is \$199,300 and Tracy Porter supports the hiring of KLJ. Motion by Commissioner Arenz and seconded by Commissioner Hatzenbuhler to award engineering services to KLJ in the amount of \$199,300. Motion passes 5-0. Brad Krogstad; KLJ Engineering

presented a summary of the bidding process. Mr. Krogstad stated that we want to bid the dome manufacture first and design around their specifications as each dome is constructed differently. The plan would be to construct the dirt work, utilities, and then follow up with the tennis courts, parking lot, and then erect the dome once near completion. We are estimated to complete the project late fall of 2022.

**Item #4:** Director Higlin requested approval to advertise request of proposals for engineering services to renovate Faris Field as fast pitch fields and update our master plan with cost estimates to reconfigure diamonds 9-12, along with cost estimates for synthetic turf fields for both complexes. Director Higlin stated that a selection committee will be made up of Commissioner Hatzenbuhler, Dave Frueh, Dustin Fleck, Mandan Baseball Club representative, and Girls Fast Pitch representative. Motion by Commissioner Arenz and seconded by Commissioner Froehlich to advertise for engineering services for Faris Field and Youth Baseball Complex. Motion passes 5-0.

**Item # 5:** Director Higlin presented bids for the Old Red Trail Phase 2 reconstruction NDDOT project. The Park District was awarded \$168,237 in grant funds and total cost of the project is \$238,322.49. The local share is \$119,885.49 which will be special assessed back to the park district. Motion by Commissioner Mehlhoff and seconded by Commissioner Hatzenbuhler to approve the bids in the amount of \$238,322.49. Motion passes 5-0.

Item # 6: President Meschke stated that annually we complete an evaluation on Director Higlin and wanted to consider a different option. President Meschke stated that each Commissioner will complete the evaluation and meet one on one with Director Higlin. Once each Commissioner has met with Director Higlin, email the evaluation to President Meshke, who will summarize the evaluation and meet with Director Higlin along with Vice President Arenz.

**Item #7:** Commissioner/Staff Reports: Director Higlin reminded the board of the upcoming Christmas Staff Luncheon and 2022 Capital Outlay items that will be bid and or purchased after Jan. 1, 2022. Accounting Manager Welch provided an overview of our new High Deductible Health Plan with NDPHIT. Currently we have staff signed up for 8 single, 6 employee/spouse, 1 employee/children, and 6 family. The total savings to the park district is \$87,568 which includes the health savings account contributions.

Motion by Commissioner Arenz and seconded by Commissioner Mehlhoff to approve the monthly bills. Motion passes 5-0.
