### Mandan Park District Board Meeting Minutes June 12, 2017

The Board of Park Commissioners duly met in regular session on Monday, June 12, 2017 at Ed "Bosch" Froehlich Meeting Room, City Hall. Those present were President Arenz, Vice President Knoll, Commissioner Hatzenbuhler, Commissioner Meschke and Commissioner McPherson.

President Arenz called the meeting to order at approximately 5:30 pm, CDT. President Arenz asked for approval of the minutes for the May 8, 2017 regular meeting. Motion was made Commissioner McPherson, seconded by Commissioner Knoll. Motion passes.

#### **Unfinished Business:**

- 1. Memorial Ballpark Renovation. Director Higlin stated that proposals were due June 9<sup>th</sup> at 10:30am. Two proposals were received. KLJ and Sambatek. Interview will be the week of June 19<sup>th</sup>.
- 2. Starion Sports Complex. Director Higlin stated synthetic grass is being installed this week. The letters, numbers and logos are going to be sewn on the turf. There is about 3 feet of sand base on the track and hopefully get paved within a week or two. The final completion of the track is mid-August. The grandstands should be completed the middle of next week. The press box will take about 3 weeks. The practice rinks are about 80% painted. There is about 90 days' worth of work that needs to be completed. The locker room won't be done on time for any of the 2017 football games.
- 3. All Seasons Arena. Director Higlin stated that the bids are being advertised. Bid opening is June 29<sup>th</sup>.

### **New Business:**

- 1. Mahlum Goodhart 2016 Audit Presentation. Lynnell Rude from Mahlum Goodhart stated a clean opinion was issued on the financial statements. There were no noncompliant issues to report. Total assets of the park district including Raging Rivers is \$26,988,000 at the end of 2016, total liability if \$4,814,000 and deferred revenue is \$1,386,000. Which is a net position of \$20,787,000. Under statement of activities, the total increase for the government in net position is 6.8 million dollars and the business type activities increased \$135,000. Total sales tax from the city in 2016 was 5,709,000 to aid in the construction of the Starion Sports Complex. Net assets for the year increased \$7,278,982, which includes the construction in progress for the Starion Sports Complex. The total overall increase in general fund balances is \$347,298. Motion was made by Commissioner Meschke, seconded by Commissioner Hatzenbuhler. Motion passes.
- Approve pledge of securities. Heide Delorme, Accounting manager stated that the Mandan Park District Commissioners are required semiannually to approve pledges and securities. Except for the bank of North Dakota. Motion was made to approve the pledge of securities reports from Starion Financial, Dakota Community Bank and BNC by Vice President Knoll, seconded by Commissioner Meschke. Motion passes.

### Commissioner/Staff Reports

Heide Delorme, accounting manager stated that they were going through the portfolio meetings this week. The annual retreat will be July 24. The first reading of the budget will be August 23<sup>rd</sup>. and the final reading will be September 11<sup>th</sup>. The sales tax is about 10% above last year. Last year it was about 1.7 million in collections and the minimum payment 1.1 million and any additional goes to principles.

Authorization of payment of the monthly bills. Motion was made by Vice President Knoll, seconded by Commissioner McPherson. Motion passes.
