Mandan Park District Board Meeting Minutes September 12, 2016

The Board of Park Commissioners duly met in regular session on Monday, September 12th, 2016 at Ed "Bosch" Froehlich Meeting Room, City Hall. Those present were President Arenz, Vice President Knoll, Commissioner Meschke, Commissioner Hatzenbuhler and Commissioner McPherson.

President Arenz called the meeting to order at approximately 5:30 pm, CDT. President Arenz asked for approval of the minutes for August 8th regular meeting and August 24th special meeting. Motion was made by Vice President Knoll, seconded by Commissioner McPherson. Motion passes.

Unfinished Business:

- Consider for approval ASA selection committee recommendations for architectural services. Director Higlin stated 5 applications were received for the renovation of the All Seasons Arena. Those interested were Joesph Larrivee Architct, JLG, Al Fritterer Architect, ICON, and EAPC. Of the five, the selection committee that was made up of Rick Horn; Board Member, Mike Bitz; Superintendent, Mark Weist; Athletic Department, and with the Park District, Wade Meschke, Dave Frueh and Cole Higlin. It was narrowed down to two, JLG and ICON, and was unanimously awarded to ICON at 5.5% Phase 1 there is not cost associated with that which includes construction costs, schematic designs, two public hearings with the user groups and a final presentation back to both the Park Board and the School Board to proceed with those costs. The estimated time line to have something back is January 1, 2017 to have a better idea of what it would cost to have it renovated, what will actually go into it and once we have the two public hearings from the user groups there will be public hearing associated with the results. Motion was make by Commissioner McPherson, seconded by Commissioner Hatzenbuhler. Motion passes.
- Authorize legal language for Dakota Star Gymnastics donation associated with Starion Sports
 Complex. Director Higlin stated that Dakota Star Gymnastics secured exclusive naming rights to their
 gymnasium portion to Midco. In the agreement it is \$125,000 donation for 15 years for exclusive
 naming rights. Motion was made by Vice President Knoll, seconded by Commissioner Hatzenbuhler.
 Motion passes.

New Business:

- Request from Mandan Baseball Club to consider renovation to Memorial Ballpark and to approve
 capital fundraiser. Damian Huettl with the Mandan Baseball Club is requesting approval to move
 forward with renovating Veterans memorial Ballpark. He is hoping for \$1 million, and the Baseball Club
 would contribute \$500,000. The baseball club would raise the additional funds. Motion was made by
 Commissioner Meschke to commit to \$500,000 to renovate Veterans Memorial Ballpark and reviewing
 a timeline spring 2017, seconded by Commissioner McPherson. Motion passes.
- Summer Recap of Recreation programs. Dave Frueh, Recreation Manager stated the number where down this year in baseball, but still had over 500 kids. Tennis is a strong program. Over 100 kids every year. Nicole Scherr, Recreation Specialist stated numbers are up for Summer MAC. There are always kids on the waiting list, but if there is not enough staff or classrooms. The art program is down a little bit but only two classes were offered and not four. Naomi Erdahl, Recreation Specialist stated that number have been very good for Track and Field. Anything over 100 is successful for Mandan. The most participants are ages five through eight, but we have a great number age nine through twelve as well. There was a little bit of a change in Sand Volleyball. There was no Wednesday coed league, just the Thursday night woman's league. Next summer 6 on 6 coed will be offered.

- Consider for approval upgrades to hole #14 at PWGC. Brad Olson, Golf Manager is asking for \$30,000 out of the operating budget of 2016 to make changes to Hole 14 retention ditch. This includes planting suitable vegetation on the ditch floor and east bank, adding rock for bank stability, water retention, golf cart barrier and aesthetic. Motion was made by Commissioner Hatzenbuhler, seconded by Commissioner Meschke. Motion passes.
- Approve the final budget reading of Ordinance No. 1048 making the annual appropriations for expenditures of the Park District of the City of Mandan, North Dakota for the fiscal year commencing January 1, 2017, ending December 31, 2017, and making the annual tax levy for the year 2016. Motion was made by Commissioner McPherson, seconded by Vice President Knoll. Motion passes.

Commissioner Reports

- Director Higlin stated that the first payment was made on the Sports Complex in the amount of \$382,433.
- Kara Haff, Raging Rivers Manager stated that Raging Rivers will be around a \$100,000 profit. About 45,000 people came through the park this year, had about 49,000 people last year.
- Dustin Fleck, Park Superintendent stated Kiwanis Park is almost completed.
- Dave Frueh, Recreation Manager stated fall programs are up and running. The hockey schedule for October is done.
- > Brad Olson, Golf Manager stated they will be hosting the West Region for the girls class A, and also the girl's state tournament.

Authorization of payment of the monthly bills. Motion made by Commissioner McPherson, seconded by Vice President Knoll. Motion passes.
