Mandan Park District Board Meeting Minutes September 9, 2019

The Board of Park Commissioners duly met in regular session on Monday, September 9, 2019 at Ed "Bosch" Froehlich Meeting Room, City Hall.

Attendees:

Park Commissioners: President Wade Meschke, Vice President Arenz, Wanda Knoll and Miles Mehlhoff. Commissioner Hatzenbuhler was absent

Park District Staff present: Director Cole Higlin, Park Superintendent Dustin Fleck, and Accounting Manager Teri Welch

President Meschke called the meeting to order at approximately 5:30pm, CDT.

<u>Public Communication:</u> No one appeared.

<u>Minutes</u>: Motion by Commissioner Knoll and seconded by Commissioner Mehlhoff to approve the August 12, 2019 regular meeting minutes and the August 27, 2019 special meeting minutes. Motion passes 4-0.

Unfinished Business:

<u>Item # 1:</u> Park Superintendent Fleck updated the board on the first HA Kautzman Design Committee meeting. The goal is to have a final design and cost to the Park Commissioners by November 2019 and to approve in December 2019. The first meeting was to prioritize the needs which include playground equipment, combined bb and tennis court, single track mountain bike trail, and access for sledding while maintaining a \$300,000 budget. The next meeting is scheduled for October 2, 2019.

Item # 2: Director Higlin stated we still have not closed out the Memorial Ballpark construction project due to Astroturf. We are holding back \$130,000 payment to Astroturf until we receive the remaining 32 inserts, 3 rolls of the extra turf, and addressing the warranty paperwork. Director Higlin stated that we have an eight year warranty that started in June 2019, but have not received the proper paper work. The Mandan Baseball Club added netting along the foul territory which be installed later this fall. In addition air conditioning units were installed in both lower level buildings. These items are not part of our current contract.

New Business:

Item #1: Director Higlin presented the 2020-2022 Mandan Baseball Club (MBC) agreement and rental rates for Memorial Ballpark. Director Higlin stated that there are three items highlighted in yellow for discussion. Director Higlin stated that the Mandan Baseball Club is requesting that we seek approval for any scheduling in Memorial Ballpark for their approval. Director Higlin stated that we will continue to communicate with the MBC about ongoing scheduling without needing their approval for allowing outside groups to use the facility. The Park District will balance wear and tear on the facility along with bringing visitors to our facility. Commissioner Mehlhoff attended the portfolio meetings and has concerns about the MBC vetoing everything we want to bring to the facility. Attorney Ruff stated that we can remove the third highlighted area stating that we do not need their approval for scheduling events in the Park District owned facility. Motion by Commissioner Mehlhoff and seconded by Commissioner Knoll to approve the 2020-2022 MBC agreement while removing the mutual agreement request for facility rentals and approved \$150 an hour and \$350 per game for rental rates. Motion passes 4-0.

<u>Item # 2:</u> Director Higlin presented a proposal from NDDOT for reconstruction of Hwy 1806 in the amount of \$22,396.08. The proposal is for a construction easement and right of way acquisition. Director Higlin recommends approval of the proposal contingent that we secure all three access points perpetuity to the Sports Complex from Old Red Trail/Hwy 1806. Motion by Commissioner Knoll and seconded by Commissioner Mehlhoff. Motion passes 4-0.

<u>Item # 3:</u> Accounting Manager Teri Welch presented a municipal bond agreement with Starion Bond Services. The purpose of the agreement is to update our contact information and to allow our bonding information to be public. Motion by Commissioner Knoll and seconded by Commissioner Arenz to approve the agreement as presented. Motion passes 4-0.

Item # 4: Accounting Manager Teri Welch presented the 2020 final budget hearing information.

Mandan Park District total mills for the 2019 budget were 28, and for 2020 it was recommended to go to 29 mills. The board approved decreasing .6 mills in the general fund and increasing 1.6 mills in the special assessment fund. The need to increase the special assessments fund levy is due to significant special assessment projects in the near future. The net effect of the mill value increase is \$11.25/year on a \$250,000 home with no valuation increase.
