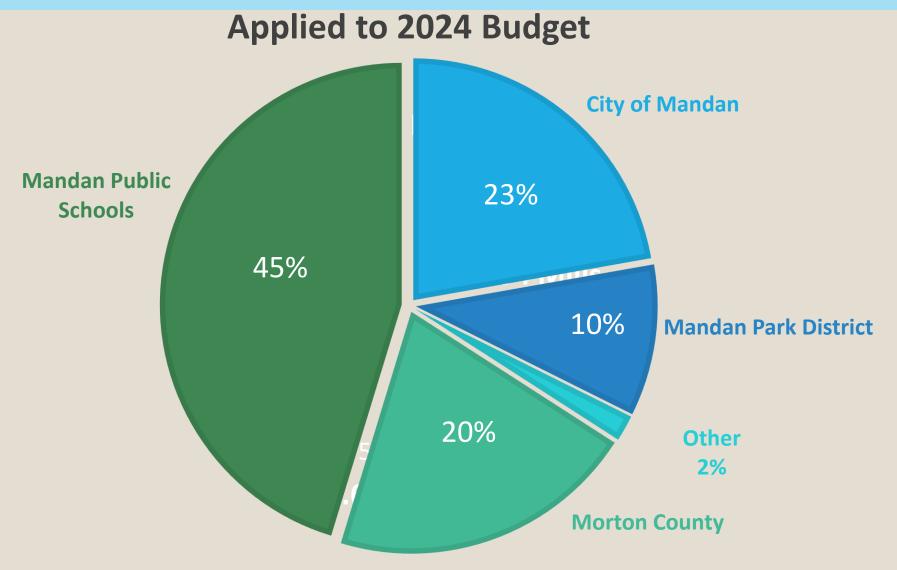

BUDGET CALENDAR

By August 10The Park District will provide a copy of the preliminary 2025 budget statement2024and notice of public budget hearing date to the Morton County Auditor.

By August 31The Morton County Treasurer will provide a written notice to the owner of
each parcel of taxable property with the total estimated property tax,
based on the preliminary 2025 budget statement, and the date, time, and
location of the public budget hearing.

September 9The Park District will conduct a public budget hearing at 5:30 pm at Mandan2024City Hall. The Park Board will pass Ordinance 1056 approving the 2025 Budget
and Certificate of Levy.

September 10The Park District will submit a certified copy of the Levy and a2024Certified copy of the 2025 Budget to the Morton County Auditor.
