



Winter Daze Volleyball Rules January 18 & 19, 2025

The following information is important, so be sure to read it over carefully and share the information with your players.

All managers must check in and initial their final roster prior to their first match.

Any player added to a team's roster must not change the division they are entered in.

1. All pool play matches will consist of two rally point sets only. A set will consist of a minimum of 21 points with a two-point advantage and will be capped at 23 points. A team will earn a point with a win during pool play matches. Team records will be determined by SET RECORD.
2. Set time is forfeit time for all games. The score of a forfeited set will be 21-0. The score of a forfeited match will be 2-0. Four players are required to start the match. In Coed you may not have more men than women. Regular Coed rules apply.
3. Two thirty-second time-outs per set.
4. No dark soled shoes, alcohol or smoking in the building, this includes the odor of alcohol.
5. All Tournament Play matches will consist of the best 2 out of 3 sets to 25 points. The first two sets will be capped at 27 points. If a third set is needed, it will be played to 15, with a cap of 17. All matches will use rally point scoring. No cap in the third set of Championship match. Must win by two.
6. Substitutions may be free (a new player in after each rotation at the center back position). Late players may not enter the set until a rotation has taken place.
7. Times: The first match for each team will start on time as per the schedule. All other matches will begin on time or immediately after the previous match on the court is finished. There will be a 2-minute warm-up period allowed before each match unless we are behind schedule. Be ready to play 30 minutes before your scheduled match time. If the court is available and your team is not ready to play, you will forfeit the first set of the match. Ten minutes later your team will forfeit the second set and, thus, the match.
8. Managers must sign the score sheet immediately after the match is completed. Make sure the scores are correct before you sign the score sheet. Once the score sheet is signed, corrections will not be made.
9. All children must be seated in the gymnasium and supervised. Officials will stop matches and remove players to take care of their children.
10. The server may serve anywhere across the end line.
11. USVBA Rules will apply regarding rules not specifically addressed above.

TIE-BREAKING METHOD

1. SET RECORD.
2. Results of match between tied teams (head to head competition).
3. Point differential of games between tied teams.
4. Point differential based on total competition.
5. Coin Flip

Awards

- Long sleeve Winter Daze T-shirts will be awarded to the winners (Including the silver bracket if there is one).
- Koozies will be awarded to the second place teams.

Unsportsmanlike Conduct

- Captains are responsible for the conduct of their players. No player shall at any time lay a hand upon, shove, strike, threaten, or verbally abuse an official, player, teammate, or spectator. If this occurs, officials and/or the Recreation Supervisor have the right to eliminate the player from the tournament.
