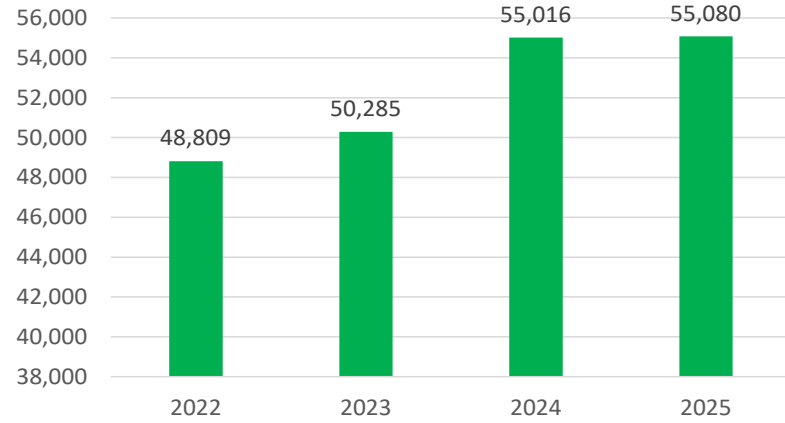


# Golf

**Rounds of Golf**

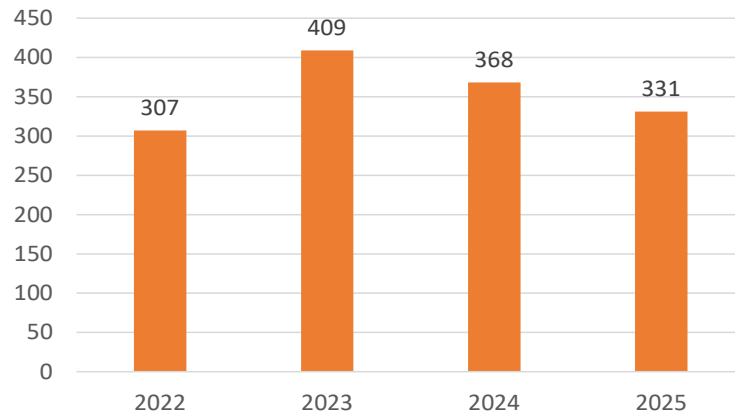


- PW Season was 226 days. (March 22nd through November 2nd)

- 14 Rodeo/ Agriculture events, 2 professional rodeos, 6 youth/ high school rodeos, Morton County Ag Days at the Dale Pahlke Rodeo Arena
- Car Bodies is complete and installed a fish cleaning station, pedestrian bridge, vault toilet
- Park Improvements- epoxy coated floor at the Eagles Park indoor shelter
- Softball/ baseball- diamonds 9 & 10 turf and new grandstand, irrigation improvements, two new storage sheds at baseball north softball building upgrades
- Renovations complete at Faris Field and will be playable in 2026

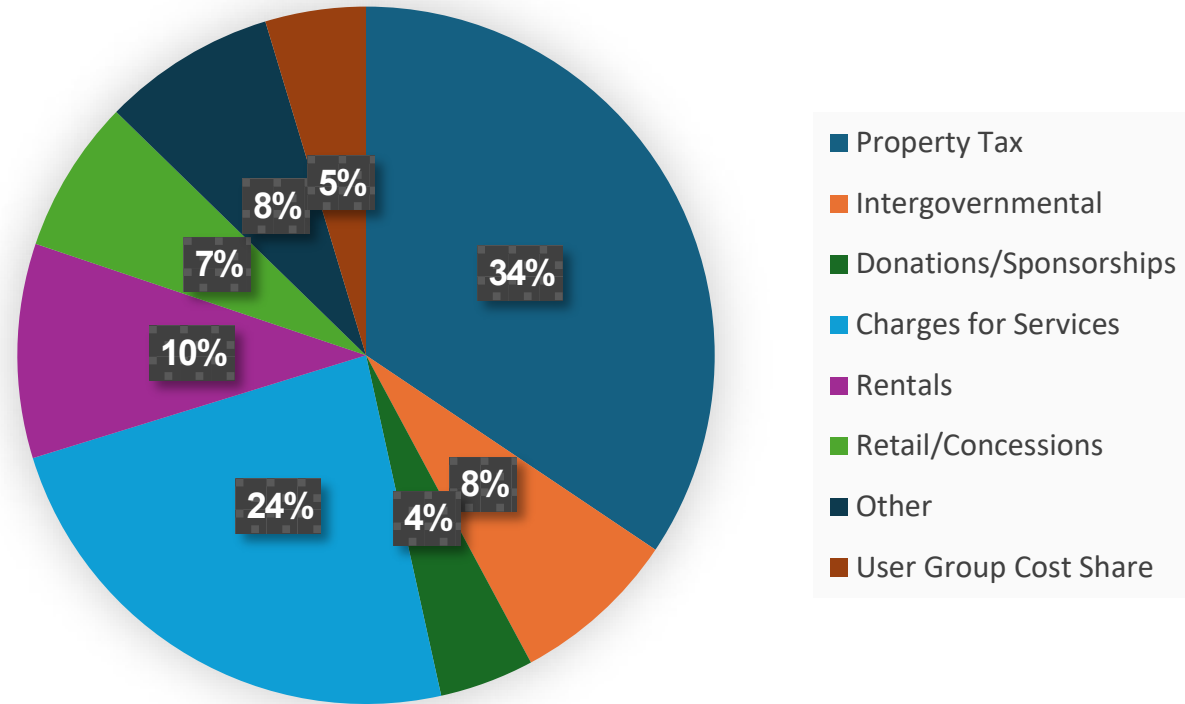

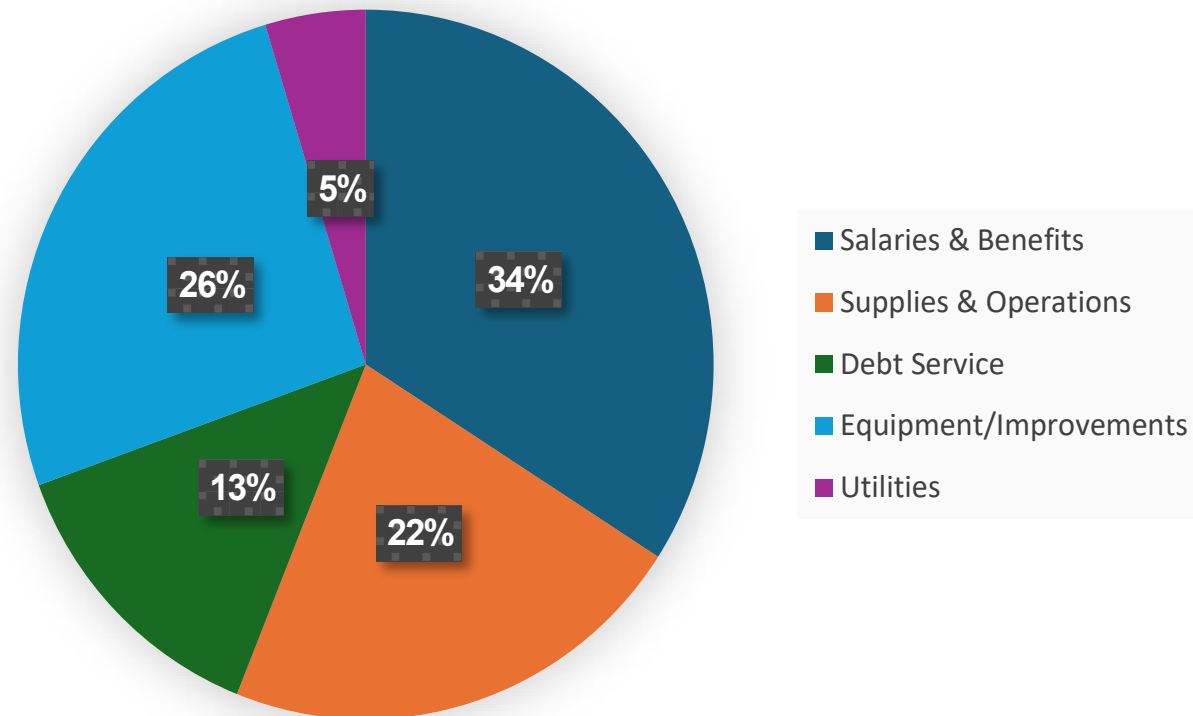

- Awarded matching grant dollars to Mandan Soccer Club, Dakota Star Gymnastics, Mandan Horse & Saddle and Mandan Softball Association

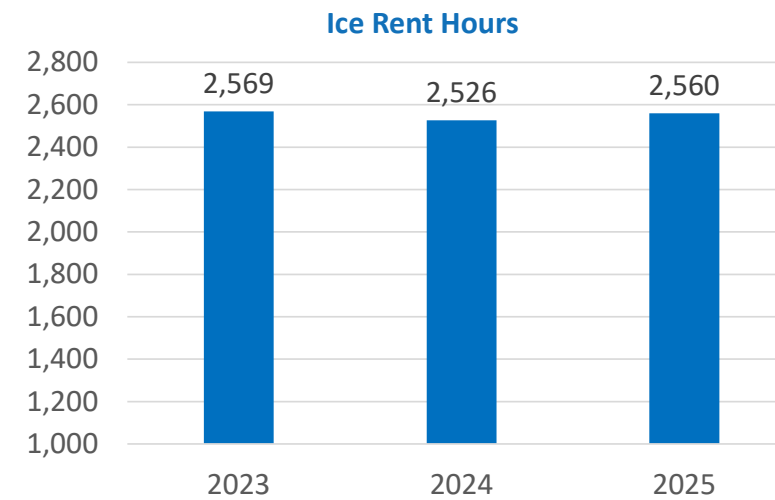

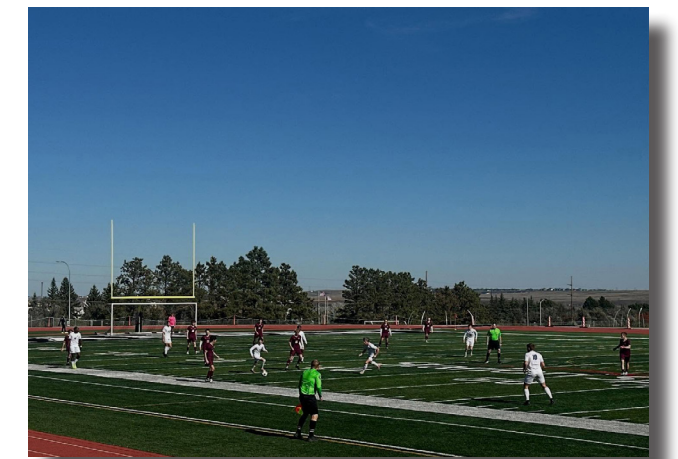

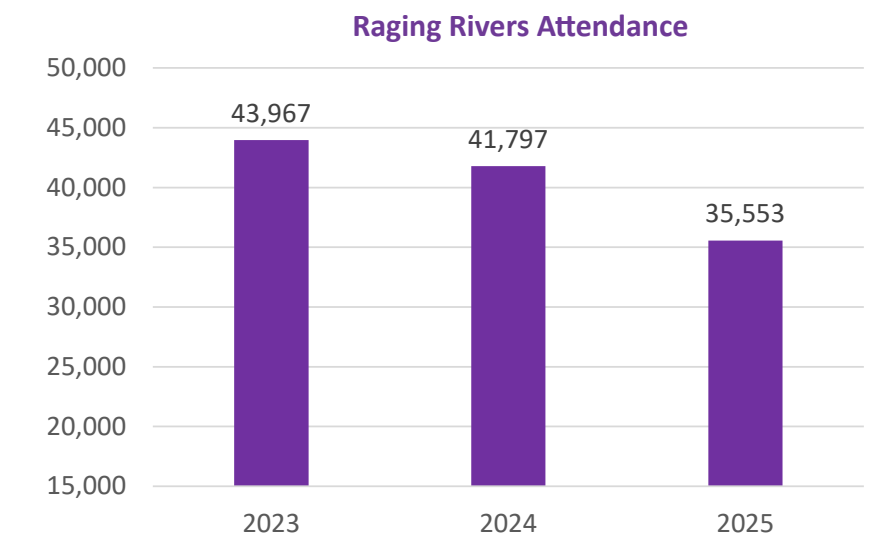
